

TERMS OF USE FOR CONTENT AVAILABLE IN SAMUEL

Welcome to SAMUEL (www.copibecdigital.ca) An innovation developed by Copibec

These Terms of Use (the "Terms of Use") create a legal agreement between you and Copibec concerning access to and use of SAMUEL. PLEASE READ THE TERMS OF USE CAREFULLY before navigating in the website.

- I. Browsing through SAMUEL without being a subscriber is allowed only for consultation purposes. Under those circumstances you are not allowed to use the content available in SAMUEL in any way whatsoever or for any purpose whatsoever such as copying, communicating or performing in public. If you would like to use the available content, please email Copibec at licences@copibec.qc.ca to become a subscriber.
- II. By subscribing to the SAMUEL site (www.copibecdigital.ca), you agree to comply with the Terms of Use for Content Available in SAMUEL set out herein, with the provisions set out in the Terms and Conditions for Access to and Use of the Site, and you accept the Privacy Policy.

III. DEFINITIONS

"Authorized User"

Any person who has a valid user code and password.

"Content"

Any element that can be downloaded or consulted online in SAMUEL, including (but not limited to) books, magazines, images, photos of contemporary works, press photos, sheet music, song lyrics and selections, which also covers how the Content is presented.

"Document"

Any document in PDF format transmitted to an Authorized User of SAMUEL.

"Institutional User"

Any permanent, temporary, contract or visiting member of the staff of an educational institution that is a Subscriber.

"Reproduction" or "Reproduce"

Reproducing or copying in print or digital format any Content or Document available in SAMUEL (by means of printing, photocopying, downloading or displaying) or making it available to the public by telecommunication on a learning management system or intranet limited by a control measure implemented by the Subscriber or Student User, and any necessary acts in connection with the Reproduction, such as archiving, distribution and public performance.

"Student User"

Any person who is enrolled as a student in a teaching or early childhood education program at the college or university level and who has subscribed to SAMUEL as an individual.

"Subscriber"

Any educational institution at the preschool, elementary, high school or college level that has subscribed to SAMUEL and has paid the subscription fees or, in Quebec, any educational institution, school board or entity of the ministry of education covered by the licensing agreement between Copibec and the *Ministère de l'Éducation, du Loisir et du Sport* governing the reproduction of literary works, or any postsecondary educational institution covered by the licensing agreement between Copibec and the *Fédération des cégeps* governing the reproduction of literary works, or any college-level educational institution that is a Copibec licensee.

IV. GENERAL

1. The user code and password assigned by Copibec are for your personal use only.

2. You are responsible for protecting the confidentiality of your user code and password. Copibec cannot be held liable for any unauthorized use of your user code and password. If the confidentiality of that information is compromised, please notify Copibec immediately.
3. You acknowledge that the documents made available in SAMUEL may be removed or modified at any time without prior notice.
4. Copibec reserves the right to amend and update these Terms of Use at any time without prior notice. You should therefore review them regularly.

V. CLAUSES APPLICABLE TO ALL USERS

1. Browsing, viewing Content or any similar activities are for your personal use only.
2. No browsing, viewing or similar activities may be communicated or broadcasted publicly, whether in class or elsewhere.
3. The site and all available Content are reserved solely for use by Authorized Users, who may be Institutional Users or Student Users.
4. The general terms of use for Content available in SAMUEL and for PDF Documents transmitted to you by SAMUEL during your subscription period are as follows:
 - a. You are allowed to use the Content within the following limits, which are applicable to each school year and class (preschool/elementary/high school level) or each semester and course group (college level):
 - i. Up to fifteen percent (15%) of a work (except for works specifically designed for preschool, elementary high school or college education purposes – see clause ii below).
 - ii. Up to ten percent (10%), without exceeding 25 pages, of a work specifically designed for preschool, elementary, high school or college education purposes.
 - iii. The entirety of the following:
 - Tale, short story, poem, or play appearing in a collective work
 - Periodical or newspaper article
 - Excerpt from an encyclopedia, annotated bibliography or other similar reference work
 - Written transcription of a musical work taken from a book or periodical, as long as all the reproduced pages do not exceed fifteen percent (15%) of the total number of pages in the collective work.
 - iv. Notwithstanding clauses i) and ii) above, the entirety of certain Content that can be selected individually in SAMUEL, such as images, photos of contemporary works, press photos, sheet music and song lyrics.
 - b. Reproducing Content or a Document is prohibited in the following instances:
 - i. Systematic or cumulative Reproduction of the same work beyond the limits set out in clause 4 a) above, such as successive downloading of different excerpts from the same work.
 - ii. Creation of a library or collection intended to substantially replace your needs for a specific work.
 - iii. Use of a work without the author's consent in a way that infringes the author's moral rights.
 - iv. For the purpose of being made available for sale or compiling textbooks or exercise books.
 - v. For the purpose of using Documents during more than one school year (preschool, elementary and high school levels) or semester (college level).
 - c. Copies must be made from a work legitimately acquired in SAMUEL by an Authorized User and must accurately represent the original.

- d. The bibliographic data and any legal notices that are automatically included by SAMUEL in each Document's watermark must clearly and visibly appear on every copy. Said notices and any reminders appearing as a footnote on each page may not be modified, altered or removed by any means whatsoever.
- e. During the subscription period: Each Document must be used as reported in the corresponding copy log entry. A new request must be made for any other use.
- f. After the expiry of the subscription period: Any reproduced Document must be destroyed. To obtain the Document again, you must renew your subscription and make a new request in SAMUEL.
- g. Specific permission from Copibec or the Rightsholder is required for any Reproduction that does not comply with these terms and conditions.

VI. CLAUSES SPECIFIC TO INSTITUTIONAL USERS

1. The specific terms of use for Documents transmitted to Institutional Users during the subscription period are as follows:
 - a. The Documents must be used solely for educational or training purposes for the benefit of the Subscriber's students.
 - b. You are authorized to:
 - i. Reproduce a Document and distribute it to the students in your class or course group;
 - ii. Store a Document on a secure telecommunications network that only your students can access;
 - iii. Use a computer or any other device to display a Document in class;
 - c. The maximum number of copies of a Document that may be made corresponds to the number of students in the class or course group plus a few additional copies for staff.
 - d. Appropriate steps must be taken to ensure that digital format copies made available to your students are not subject to unauthorized Reproduction or distribution.
 - e. If Reproduction is done outside your educational institution by an outsourcer or subcontractor at your request and expense or at the request and expense of your educational institution, you must ensure compliance with all provisions of these terms and conditions.

VII. CLAUSES SPECIFIC TO STUDENT USERS

1. The terms of use for Documents by Student Users during their subscription period are as follows:
 - a. The Documents must be used only for research or study by the Student User for his or her personal benefit.
 - b. You are authorized to:
 - i. Reproduce a Document so that it can be included in your schoolwork.
 - a) In this case, the maximum number of copies is three (3).
 - ii. Use a computer or any other device to display a Document in class for the course group that you are enrolled in as a student.
 - iii. Make a digital format copy of a Document and share it with one of your professors by email or a secure intranet as part of your schoolwork.

- iv. Share a digital version of a Document or Content for your group schoolwork with other students who are also subscribed to SAMUEL as individuals.
- c. If you use SAMUEL as a student teacher or during a practicum in a Subscriber institution, you are subject to the same rights and obligations as the Institutional User. Please refer to Section VI. However, even in that case, browsing or viewing Content or any similar activities remain strictly limited to your personal use.
